PRO TIP!

Here is a good way to paint the eyes. The key is to make the irises a good size, then finish using your favorite paints, brushes and color pencils.

STEP 1
Apply a gray undercoat.

STEP 2
Pay attention to the shadows casted by the eyelids and eyelashes.

STEP 3
Draw the irises while watching the size.

STEP 4
Add color and detail to the irises.

STEP 5
Draw the eyeliner and paint the corners of they eyes pink.

STEP 6
Draw the pupils in the center of the irises.

FINISH!

Labels: white, pink, pale blue

Note: The outline of irises should be thicker on the top and thinner on the bottom.

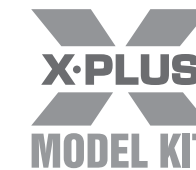

IMPORTANT – READ THIS FIRST!

- This model needs to be assembled. Please read the instructions carefully before assembling the model.
- After removing the product from the plastic bag, tear the plastic bag and dispose of it in a safe place, as there is a danger of suffocation if young children mishandle it.
- Carefully remove the parts from the trees and discard the trees after removing all parts.
- Due to the manufacturing process, sharp points may be present that could cause harm. Do not play with or mishandle the trees, and do not use them for anything other than their intended purpose. Households with young children should be particularly cautious.
- Use nippers to remove parts, and smooth any burrs remaining on parts with a craft knife or file. Exercise caution when using nippers, craft knives, or files, as they can cause cuts to hands or fingers. Children under 10 years old should have a parent or guardian carry out the work.

- Avoid leaving this product in areas exposed to direct sunlight, high temperatures, or high humidity.

FOR SUGGESTED DETAIL PAINTING SCHEME – SEE ILLUSTRATIONS. Paint parts as indicated and allow to dry before assembling.

NOTE!

PLEASE TEST FIT PARTS BEFORE GLUING TO ENSURE PROPER FIT.

Step 1: Assembling the head.

Attach teeth parts #7 and #8 to #6 from inside. Then attach #5 to #6. Next, attach hair parts #4, #2, #3 and #1 on top of the head as shown. You can add the earrings #64 and #65 at this point.

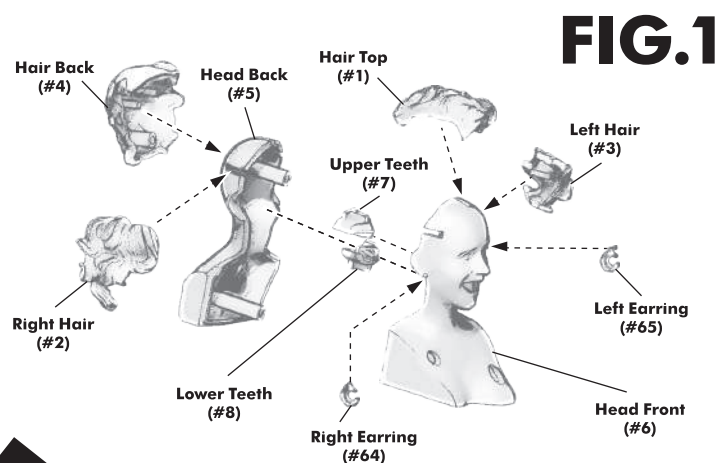

Step 2: Assembling the torso.

Clamp the head assembly in Step 1 between #9 and #10. Then attach #11 and #26. Next, #20 and #21 and lastly, attach #29 and #30 to the front of the torso.

Step 3: Assembling the arms.

Attach #15 to #16, then attach #31 to #32 and attach them to the sleeve. Attach #24 to #25. Then attach #33 and #34 to #35. Finish by attaching the assembled hand to the left arm.

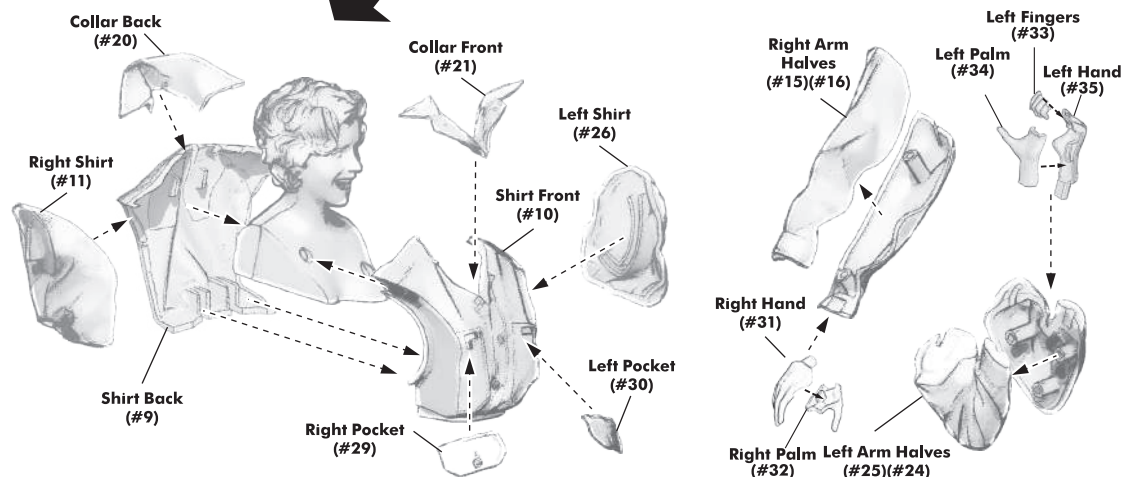
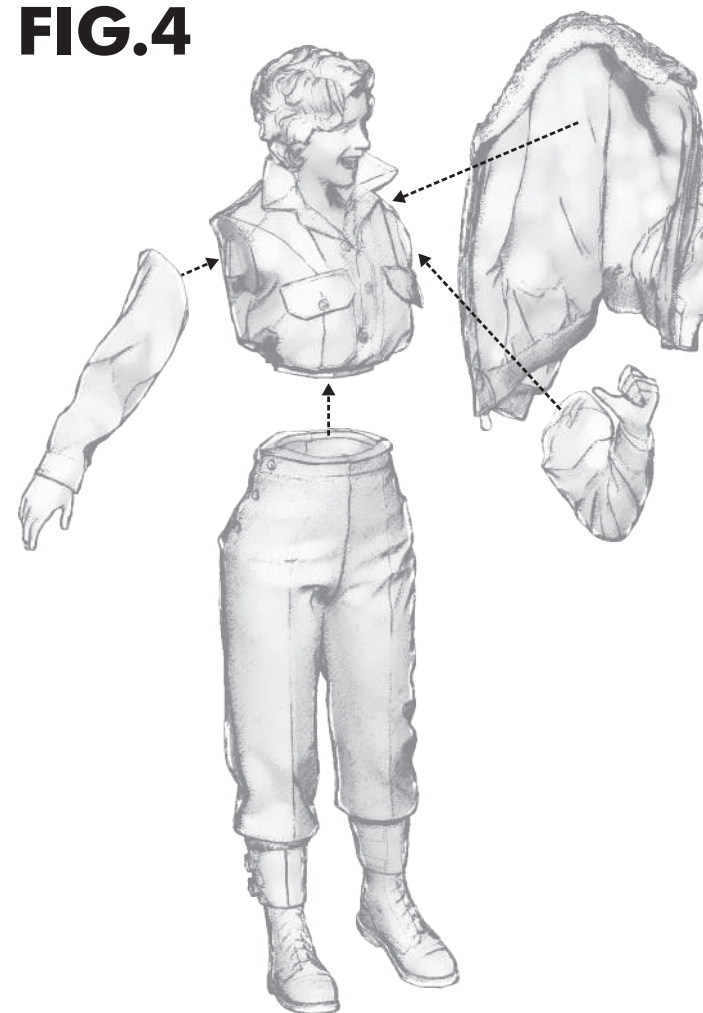

Step 6: Assembling the character.

Attach the finished arms to the torso and then the finished jacket to the left shoulder. Then, assemble the torso to the legs.

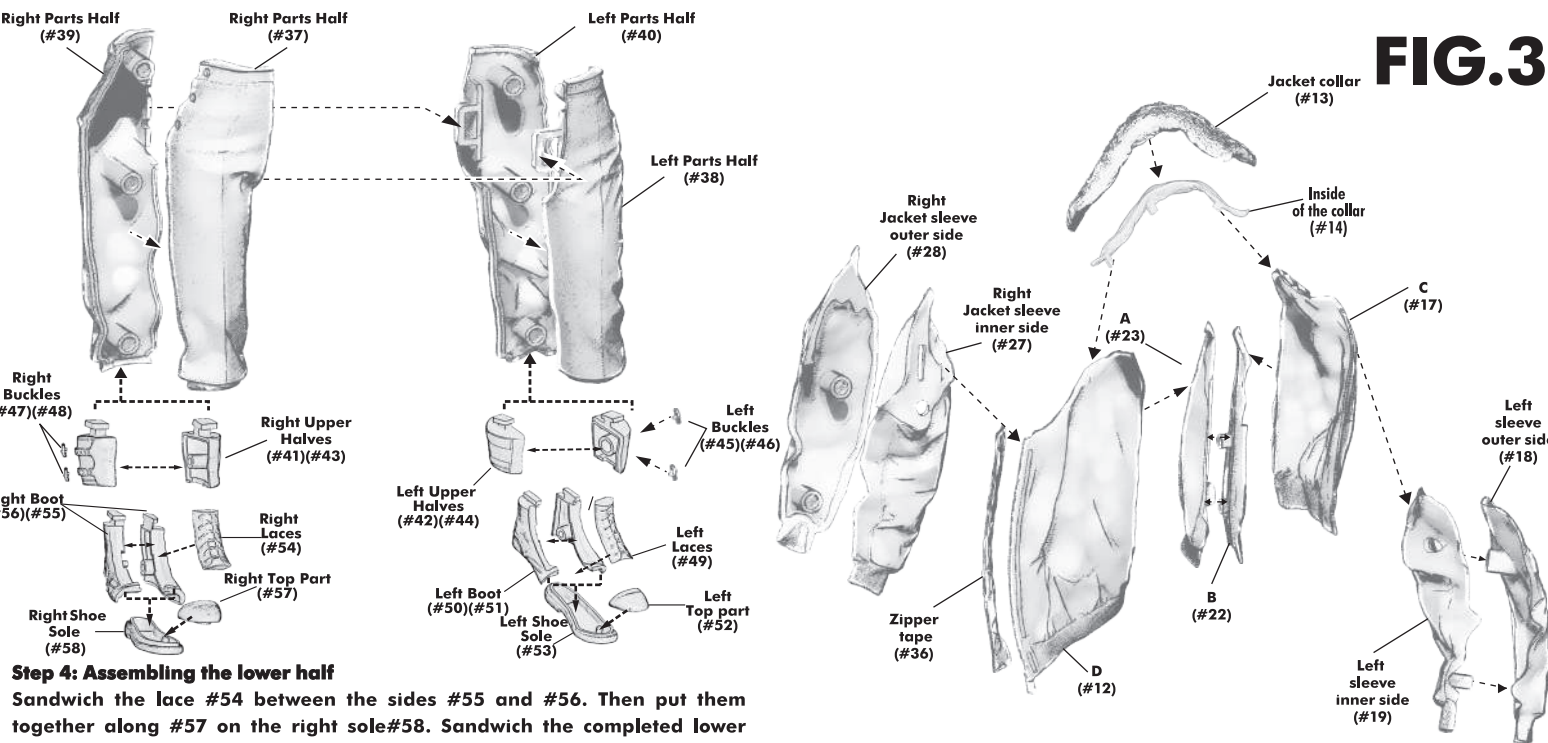

Step 4: Assembling the lower half

Sandwich the lace #54 between the sides #55 and #56. Then put them together along #57 on the right sole#58. Sandwich the completed lower part between the upper halves #44and #42. Stick the buckles #47 and #48 to the upper half. The right boot is now completed. Sandwich the lace #49 between the sides #50 and #51. Then put them together along #52 on the left sole#53. Sandwich the completed lower part between the upper halves #42 and #44. By sticking the buckles #45 and #46 ,the left boot is also completed. Finish the lower half by inserting the completed right boot between #37 and #39 and the left one between #38 and #40. Then attach the completed legs together.

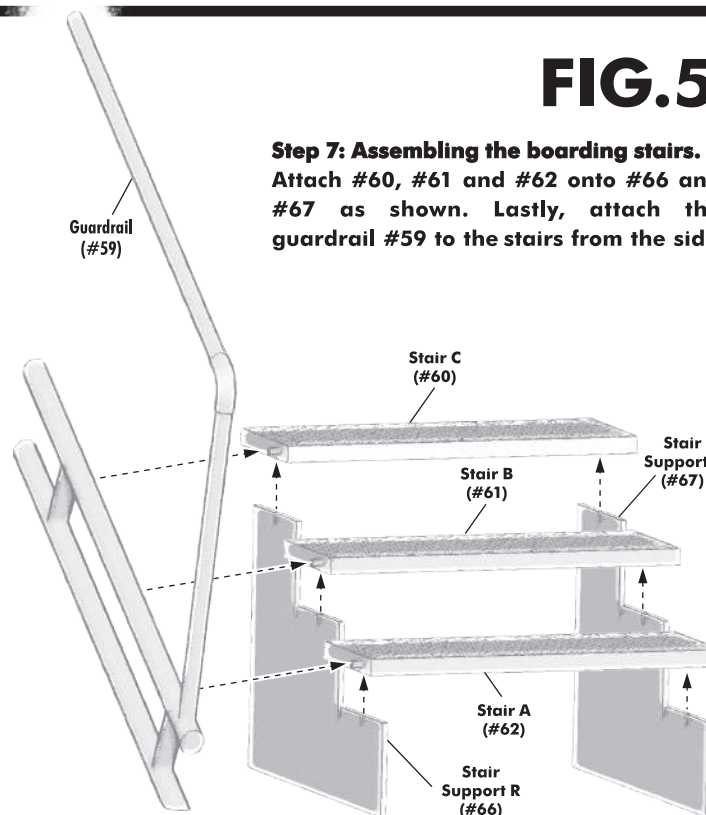
Step 5: Assembling the jacket.

Attach #23 to #22 and #36 to #12, then attach them together. Next, attach #17 to the side and later #13and#14 on top. Lastly attach #27 to #28, and #18 to #19. Attach the assembled jacket sleeves to the jacket from the sides.

Step 7: Assembling the boarding stairs.

Attach #60, #61 and #62 onto #66 and #67 as shown. Lastly, attach the guardrail #59 to the stairs from the side.

Step 8: Completing the model.

Put the character on top of the stairs assembly from Step 7 and place the nameplate #63 next to your model. Your model is now complete, and it's time to paint!
